





We live in a complex world — solving its problems requires creative and critical thinking. Whether it's curing cancer or combating climate change, our most pressing issues require input from across disciplines. Working with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), we are excited to offer a holistic STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics) education that teaches students how to solve for the future.

IMMERSION IN TECHNOLOGY

Our interdisciplinary STEAM program, created in partnership with MIT, is all about giving your child the tools to achieve more in our tech-driven world. Through hands-on problem solving, interdisciplinary learning and developing transferable skills, our STEAM program immerses students from an early age in the intersection of programming, engineering, robotics, and design.

LEARNING FROM LEADING THINKERS

Our students and educators have the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to learn from leading MIT scientists in person. Every spring, North Broward Preparatory students visit MIT to discover the innovations shaping their future. They engage in hands-on activities from building robots to bioengineering to coding. Our STEAM teachers also participate in MIT training workshops, where they are exposed to the forefront of STEAM thinking through discussions with leading researchers.

OUT-OF-THE-BOX CHALLENGES

Uniting their knowledge of science and technology, our in-school challenges invite students to try and find innovative and creative solutions to the world's greatest puzzles. In a previous challenge, North Broward Preparatory students blended ingenuity and imagination with Nord Anglia Education peers from around the world to construct a chain reaction machine. COLLABORATIVE TEACHING

Our collaboration with The Juilliard School brings teaching artists to our school every year. Through workshops and master classes, they inspire and mentor our next generation of performers.

EMBEDDED CURRICULUM

Our performing arts curriculum incorporates Juilliard teaching materials to enrich our students' learning experience. Our students learn from a Juilliard-curated repertoire that encompasses a broad range of genres, styles, and cultures. Engaging activities developed by The Juilliard School help our students develop creative skills such as improvisation and composition. Our outstanding teachers use the Juilliard Creative Classroom, an online resource of teaching materials, recordings, and videos, to support your child in engaging deeply with music.

Through our collaboration with The Juilliard School, we offer an intensive two-week program, Summer Performing Arts with Juilliard, that allows all students to learn from Juilliard artists and faculty. This is a unique opportunity for students who are passionate about music, dance and drama to engage with the subjects on a deeper level. The programs are offered at three of our sister schools: Collège du Léman in Switzerland, Nord Anglia Chinese International School in Shanghai and Winderemere Preparatory School in Florida.

ART ACROSS DISCIPLINES

Our cross-arts and arts-integration projects break down the walls between the arts and academic disciplines, promoting innovative thinking and meaningful learning. 

At the heart of North Broward Preparatory's high school curriculum is the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program, a holistic and academically rigorous course of study that prepares students for global success. Spanning a wide range of disciplines and languages, the IB Diploma challenges students to be intellectually curious, culturally aware and multilingual.

LEARNING ACROSS THE LINES

Students follow an interdisciplinary curriculum that encourages critical thinking across subjects They take courses in six areas - language and literature; language acquisition; individuals and societies; sciences; mathematics; and the arts – in addition to studying the Theory of Knowledge, completing a research-based Extended Essay and participating in extracurricular programs based around Creativity, Action and Service (CAS).

SURPRISING AND DELIGHTING STUDENTS





OUR RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

Boarding students will feel right at home in our new International Village. Housing two students per bedroom, the building is complete with its own lounge/snack area, common area, study area, and Wi-Fi among other amenities, designed to foster a sense of community. Our experienced Residential Life team cares for boarding students and provides them with everything they need to succeed, academically and socially.

SAFETY FIRST

At North Broward Preparatory School, the safety and security of our students and staff members is of utmost importance. The North Broward Prep Safety and Security Team provides continuous, year-round security on campus. Security professionals and police officers patrol our campus and respond to any emergency 24 hours a day.

We want students to enjoy the expansive activities and outdoor spaces of our campus in a safe manner. Our stringent security measures, regularly reviewed and updated to ensure student safety, include:

- Nightlock classroom barricade devices in every classroom
- Bullet resistant window film on all first floor glass doors and windows in all buildings
- Full-time nursing staff
- Faculty and staff certified in First Aid, CPR, concussion protocols and defibrillator use

In addition, North Broward Preparatory School's leadership team and faculty attend regular trainings and seminars on safety, wellness and emergency preparedness and response. This school year, all faculty and staff will be trained in ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform Counter, Evacuate), highly regarded as the best program for active shooter response training.
